

## Trail etiquette

- \* Please keep your dog(s) on leash.
- \* Stay (with your dogs) on one side of trail.
- \* Do not block the trail anytime.
- \* Be aware dog teams are very quiet when moving and can't stop easily.
- \* When encountering a dog team, Stay calm, move to one side of the trail so the dog team can go by.
- \* Control is extremely important. Dog Team has the right-of-way. Keep maximum control.
- \* When approaching or overtaking another trail user, give them plenty of warning by yelling "Trail!" before you pass. Be polite and kindly announce to the person your intentions.
- \* Remember, Dog Teams are not easily stopped and sled dogs get very anxious when stopped, so get off the trail as safely and as fast as you can (control you dogs or/and equipment).
- \* Be careful if your dog has a tendency to growl, bite or attack other dogs or people. "Reactive" dogs may cause severe grief for you and others if not properly controlled.
- \* Also be on the alert for moose.

- \* ADMA trail head, on Farmers Loop road is a private property, enjoy it with respect.
- \* Trail fee for skijorer, musher, biker and other users is \$5 per day. You can also purchase a yearly membership online.
- \* ADMA is a not-for-profit organization.
- \* ADMA solely maintain and groom this trail system.
- \* Donations are greatly appreciated. Enjoy the trails.
